Special Features: The general construction package for Augusta Medical Center involved the vast majority of the general construction and architectural package including: installation of over 1,500 door frames and doors, metal fabrication and specialties, handrail system, wood blocking, building layout work, interior casework, and specialized equipment.

The Nielsen Partnership: Nielsen provided design/build services for a doctor's lounge, conference rooms, credit union offices, and additional four-pod patient room suites on the third floor of the Medical Center.

Nielsen also contracted to complete the site work at AMC, installing more than five miles of curbing and guttering, associated sidewalks, roads and parking lots, and required utility work for the entire AMC campus.

In a design/build venture with architects Odell Associates, Inc., Nielsen constructed the interior upfit of the Medical Office Building, which includes over 21 doctors' suites, a dialysis/oncology unit, a retail pharmacy, optical shops, OB/GYN offices, and more.
