Special Features: In the first phase of this renovation project, eight new science rooms were added. The administrative and guidance suite was completely redone with all new offices and conference rooms. A new gymnasium was added.

The renovation included new electricity, a new HVAC system, new paint, ceiling tiles, lights, and floor tile. The media center was completely gutted, renovated, and enclosed. The total area renovated was 159,000 square feet.
